How we keep you safe

What does keeping safe mean?

At Chorlton Park all of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important. In our school we respect our children and want to keep you safe and help to protect your rights. We do our best to help you make good educational progress.

We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourself and stay safe.

How will we try to keep you safe?

We think about what is working well, what we are worried about and what we can do next to support you. We want to ensure that you remain safe at home as well as at school.

We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.

If you need to talk, we will listen!

You can talk to any adult in school. We are all here to listen and help you. You can let your teacher know you'd like to talk by putting your lolly stick on their desk.

It is Mrs Chell's role to keep everyone safe in school. You can talk to Mrs Chell or leave a message in the drop box outside the Safeguarding office.

You can also use the Confide button on the computer to send a message us.

Don't keep it a secret if someone is:

- Bullying you
- Saying things to you that you do not like or upset you
- Touching you without your permission
- Hitting you or hurting you
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone
- Showing you things that make you uncomfortable
- Doing things that make you feel unsafe/scared
- Trying to give you cigarettes, alcohol or drugs
