

Dear Parents/Carers,

Daily Update – Tuesday 17 March

We are receiving an update from Manchester City Council at 2pm each day so we will be sending a daily email each afternoon to provide you with any updated information. Obviously, if there is any urgent information received we will pass this on immediately.

- The most significant change since yesterday is that if anyone in your home has symptoms of Covid-19 the **entire household** is now required to isolate for 14 days. Please contact school on the first day of absence.
- In line with advice in regards social distancing we are requesting that from tomorrow morning **reception and nursery parents leave children at the door to their classroom** rather than entering the classroom themselves. We feel the children are very settled in their classroom now and hope you appreciate the reason for this decision.
- Year 4 swimming lessons have been cancelled until further notice.
- We will be making a final decision tomorrow about the Year 1 trip to Chester Zoo on Friday and will communicate this on the daily update.
- We do have a significant amount of absence due to a variety of reasons but we currently have more than enough staff to meet the required staffing level.

As some families are having to self-isolate we have put together a short list of online activities for children to undertake at home. If school is required to close we will put together a more comprehensive pack of home work.
